OBJECTIVES

The department of geology at UniLaSalle offers a unique opportunity for field work in geology in FRANCE. International and French students will have the opportunity to work alongside faculty members, graduate students (peer teaching) and invited specialists. They will experience hands-on geological exploration in small groups.

Extend learning from the classroom to the field in sequence stratigraphy and with a transect of the Alps. The field school will also introduce the participants to cross-cultural management, geological mapping and petrography.





TUITION AND FEES

Tuition fees: 3500 € (waived for exchange students from partner universities)

Logistics fees: 1390 € (subject to change) for exchange and non-exchange students, including:

- Week 1: room & board on campus + OW transportation from CDG airport to UniLaSalle on May 17th, 2020: 300 €
- RT transportation Beauvais field: 300 €
- Week 2: room, board & transportation:
 320 € (Free time in Grenoble from May 29th to May 30th: nights and breakfasts are included but not lunches, diners
 & personal transportation)
- Week 3: room, board & transportation: 420 €
- Non-refundable administration fee: 50 €
